



Halal Certification **- An Overview**

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1. What is Halal Certification?

- Halal Certification implies the product has been prepared by strictly following the Islamic law.
- Halal term originated from Islam and in Arabic language means “According to religious law” or “Permissible” by Quran (Holy book of Muslim).
- In Islam, only food and beverage lawfully permitted (Halal) is allowed for consumption. Food Like Pork, Alcohol, consuming dead animals are prohibited. Hence Halal certification assures the no such product has been used.

- Islamic countries, have the halal certification given by the government.
- In India, Halal certification is given by many private companies, by marking the food or products permissible for the followers of Islam.

1.2. Halal Law?

- Animal should be slaughter by Muslim man.
- The Quranic verse must be read while slaughtering the animal
- Sharp cut to the jugular vein, carotid artery and windpipe for slaughtering.
- Only alive and healthy animal must be slaughtered.

- Before consumption, ingredients to be checked for reconfirmation.

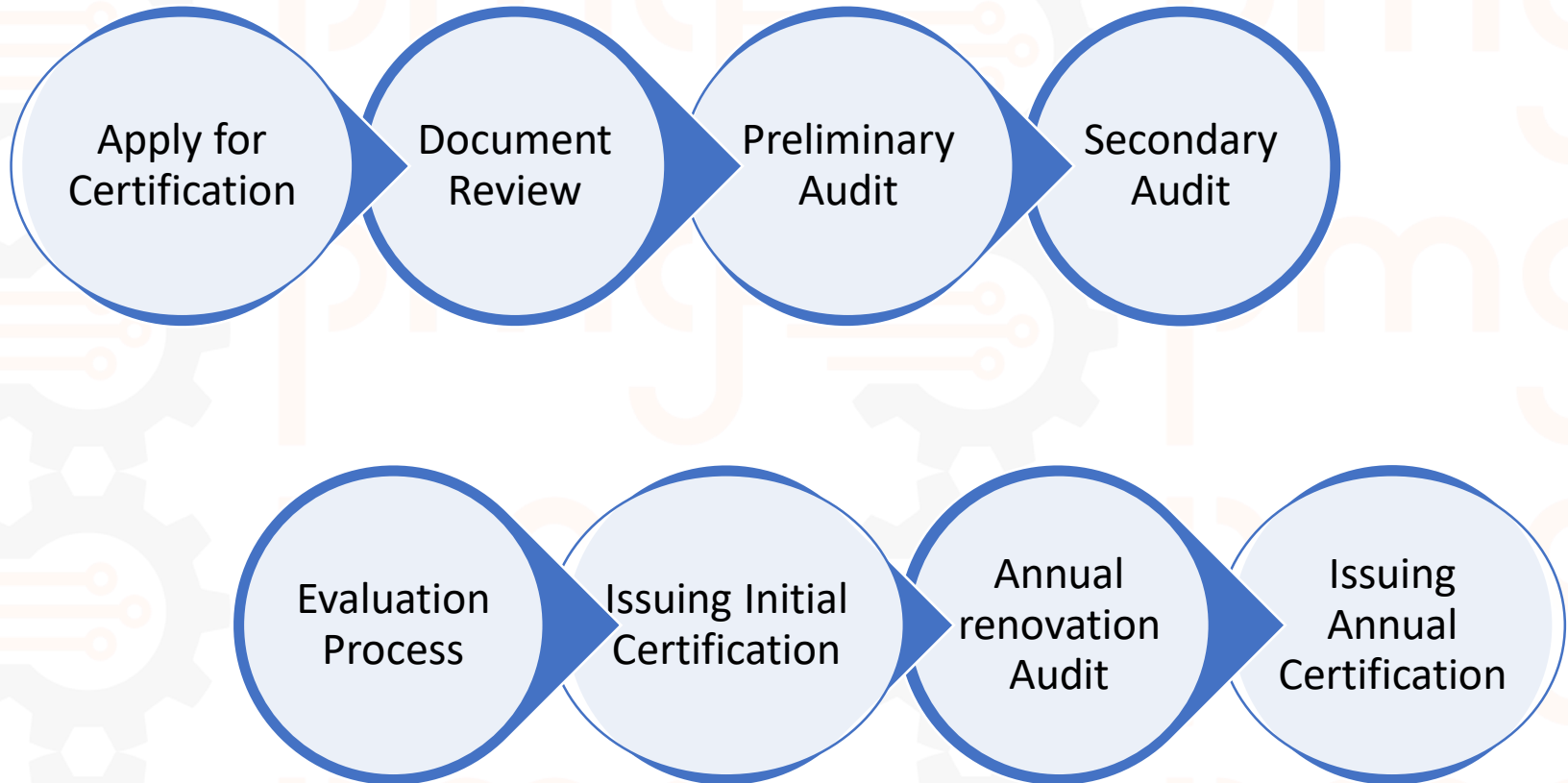
