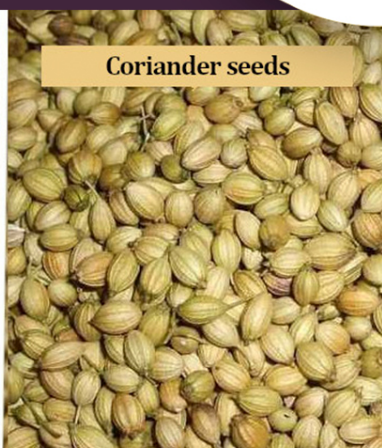

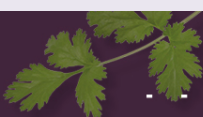
Cilantro or coriander plant



Coriander seeds

Coriander and cilantro are not the same things.

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- Cilantro is the green leafy herb of the Coriander plant, while coriander is the spice from the Coriander seed.
- The Coriander plant produces both the cilantro leaves which are also known as Chinese parsley, as well as the coriander seeds, which are used in cooking.
- Cilantro has a unique, citrusy and sometimes pungent flavor that's different from the nutty, sweet flavor of the ground coriander seed often added to dishes as a garnish or fresh herb.
- While the ground coriander powder is used to add flavor to dishes like curries, soups, and stews.
