

DOES HONEY SPOIL?

In 2015, archaeologists reported that they'd found 3,000-year-old honey while excavating tombs in Egypt, and it was perfectly edible.

Three Unique Features of Honey why Honey never spoils -

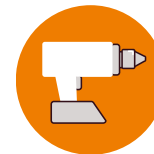
- Honey is low in water (17%) and high in sugar (83%), so bacteria cannot grow on it.
- Honey also contains small amounts of hydrogen peroxide, which inhibits growth of microbes.
- The low pH (3.5 to 4.5) of honey.

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
