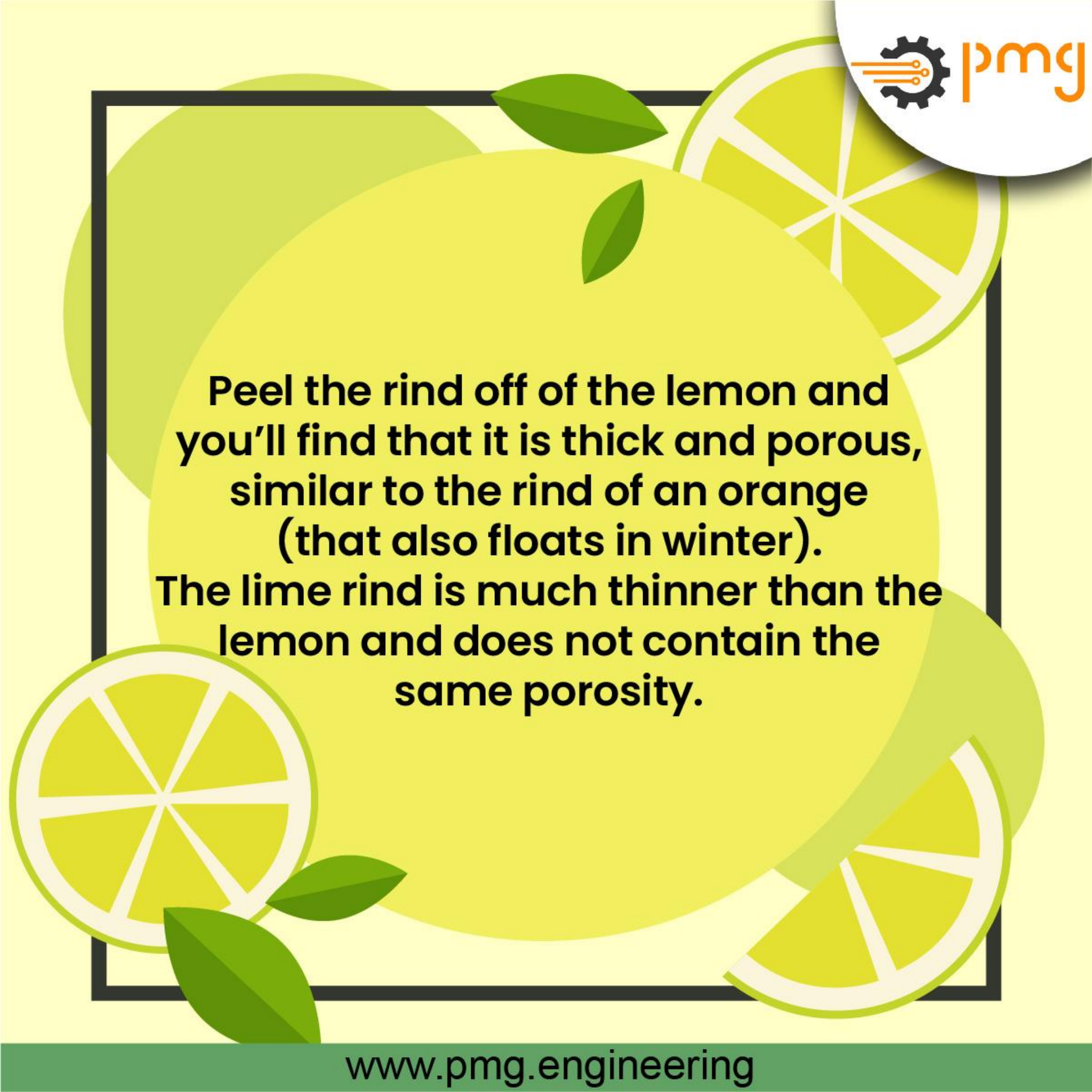

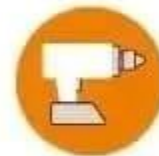
Peel the rind off of the lemon and you'll find that it is thick and porous, similar to the rind of an orange (that also floats in winter). The lime rind is much thinner than the lemon and does not contain the same porosity.

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
