***MILKSHAKES ORIGINALLY
CONTAINED ALCOHOL.***

The first time the term “milkshake” was used in print was in 1885. During this period, milkshake referred to an beverage which was an alcoholic drink described as a “sturdy, healthful eggnog type of drink” which was a blend of eggs, whiskey, and other ingredients served both as a tonic and treat at pharmacies.

In 1900, milkshakes changed to “wholesome drinks containing chocolate, strawberry, and vanilla syrup.”

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
