



SUGAR BEET EXTRACTION PLANTS

- **A sugar beet extraction plant is a type of industrial facility that is used to process sugar beets and extract sugar from them.**

Working Principle

- 1. Cleaning:** The sugar beets are washed and scrubbed to remove dirt, stones, and other impurities.
- 2. Slicing:** The clean sugar beets are then sliced into thin pieces, called cassettes.
- 3. Extraction:** The cassettes are fed into a diffuser or extraction tower, where they are mixed with hot water. The hot water helps to dissolve the sugar from the cassettes and create a sugar-rich juice.
- 4. Purification:** The sugar-rich juice is then purified to remove impurities, such as proteins and minerals. This is typically done using a combination of chemicals and filtration.
- 5. Concentration:** The purified juice is concentrated by evaporating the water, which increases the sugar concentration.
- 6. Crystallization:** The concentrated juice is then cooled and seeded with sugar crystals to encourage the formation of new sugar crystals. The resulting mixture of sugar crystals and syrup is then separated in a centrifuge.
- 7. Drying:** The separated sugar crystals are dried to remove any remaining moisture, resulting in the final product of sugar.
